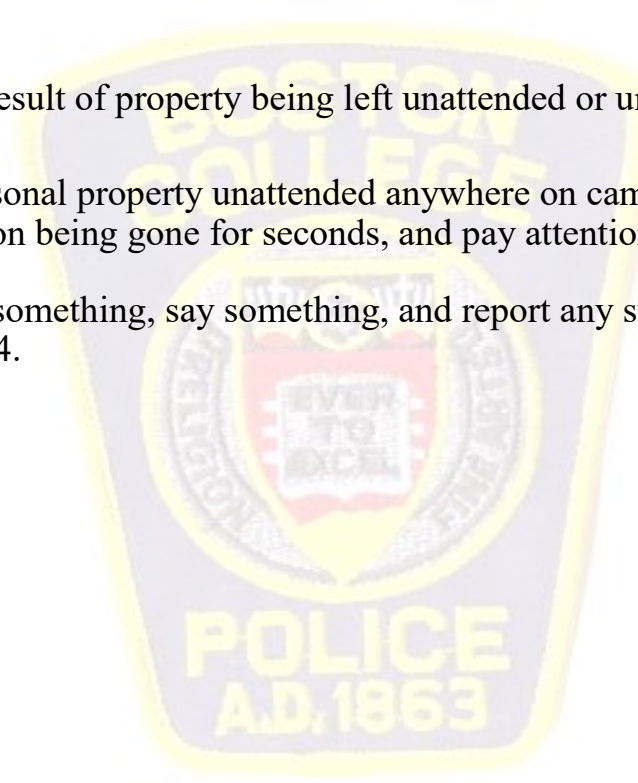
With study periods approaching, the Boston College Police Department would like to remind community members of the importance of not leaving valuables or personal property unattended for any period of time.
