On the evening of April 10th, 2019 the Boston College Police Department received a report of a white male subject committing a lewd act in a car off-campus along Commonwealth Avenue, between 2150 and 2000.

The individual was occupying a 4-door silver in color sedan with its lights on. No further description or information was provided.

Boston Police have been notified and BC Police will be increasing patrols in the area. As a precautionary reminder, the Boston College Police Department encourages you to do the following:

- Wherever you are, stay alert and aware of your surroundings.
- Avoid walking alone at night. Walk with friends or consider using the BC Eagle Escort Service by contacting 617-552-8888.
- Report suspicious behavior and activity immediately by contacting BC Police at 617-552-4444, or 9-1-1.
