On Sunday, October 6th, 2019 the Boston College Police Department received a report of a suspicious male that had been observed “peering” into ground level windows of Kostka Hall.

The individual was described as a white male, 25-35 years of age, approximately 5’7” with a red beard and goatee. The male was last seen to wearing a white sweatshirt, red baseball cap, baggy black pants and black sneakers.

The Boston College Police Department has increased patrols and visibility in the area. If anyone has information regarding this incident, please contact the Boston College Police Department at 617-552-4440.

As a reminder, the Boston College Police Department encourages you to do the following:

- Stay alert - call the police immediately to report suspicious activity or persons.
- Trust your instincts - if it does not feel right, call for help.
- If you observe something that doesn’t appear to be normal, do not approach a subject and call the police immediately.
- Keep your doors and windows locked at all times. Keep your window/door blinds drawn, especially in the evening and night hours.
