On Sunday, September 16th, 2018, the Boston Police Department reported an off-campus residential burglary that occurred in the early morning hours in the **Radnor Road neighborhoods of Brighton.**

The victim reported that an unidentified black male, approximately 6 feet tall, in his late-20's to mid-30's, with a scruffy beard, of average build, wearing dark clothing, and carrying a black backpack, had entered his second floor apartment through an unsecured door before entering his bedroom. The victim reported waking up, observing the male subject, at which time the suspect fled, exiting through the rear of the residence.

It appears nothing was taken during the incident.

As a reminder the Boston College Police Department encourages you to do the following:

- Lock **ALL** doors and windows. This includes patio doors and windows on upper floors, and keep those access points secured at all times.
- Keep items such as ladders secured and away from your residence exterior.
- Be aware of your surroundings and get to know your neighbors.
- Avoid leaving valuables in plain site from windows.
- Report suspicious activity & persons to Police **immediately**. Do not hesitate to call 9-1-1.
