CURRENTLY STUDYING ABROAD AND GUARANTEED HOUSING FOR THE '19-'20 YEAR?

As room selection is conducted online via Agora, students who are currently enrolled and studying abroad can equally participate in the process.

GOING ABROAD IN THE SPRING '20 AND GUARANTEED HOUSING FOR FALL '19?

You will go through the room selection process. In the fall semester, you will receive an email from Residential Life that your housing will be canceled for the spring semester because you are studying abroad. By December 1st, your housing for the spring will be canceled.

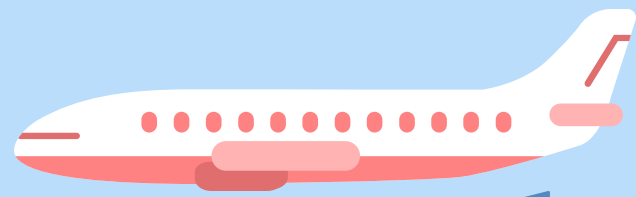
GOING ABROAD IN THE FALL '19 AND GUARANTEED HOUSING FOR SPRING '20?

You **do not** go through the full room selection process.

You do still need to declare your housing intent, and you should indicate that you do not intend to live on campus because you will be abroad. You will be contacted by our department in November to begin the housing application process for the spring semester. You will have the ability to indicate room type preferences, roommate requests or a specific room that you know will be available in the spring. You will be placed in housing by January 1st.

GOING ABROAD IN THE FALL '19 AND NOT GUARANTEED HOUSING FOR SPRING '20?

Students officially requesting to be considered for an additional semester of housing outside of their original guaranteed housing eligibility will need to fill out a housing appeal form. Appeal forms are reviewed on a rolling basis and are available under "My ResLife" in Agora.



UNSURE OF FUTURE PLANS?

Any housing eligible student unsure of their future plans should go through the room selection process.

Any eligible student who does not select a room or participate in final selection by the end of the room selection process will no longer be eligible to live in university housing and may forfeit all future claims to live in university housing.
