Complete this form only if you are interested in Work-Study employment during the summer of 2020. Please consider carefully whether you will use summer Work-Study funds before applying, as funding is limited.

If you are not interested in applying for summer Work-Study, this will not affect your eligibility for fall and spring Work-Study. Students who complete the 2020–2021 Boston College Financial Aid Application are automatically considered for fall and spring Work-Study.

### How to apply for summer Work-Study:

- Your 2020–2021 Boston College Financial Aid Application must be completed before your eligibility for summer work-study can be determined. The 2020–2021 application instructions are available at [www.bc.edu/finaidforms](http://www.bc.edu/finaidforms).
- You do not need to be enrolled in summer classes; however, you must be registered for fall 2020 classes.
- Priority consideration is given to applications received by the April 17, 2020, priority filing date. On-time applicants will be notified of their eligibility in late April.
