Complete this form only if you are interested in Work-Study employment during the summer of 2021. Please consider carefully whether you will use summer Work-Study funds before applying, as funding is limited.

If you are not interested in applying for summer Work-Study, this will not affect your eligibility for fall and spring Work-Study. Students who complete the 2021–2022 Boston College Financial Aid Application are automatically considered for fall and spring Work-Study.

How to apply for summer Work-Study:

- Your 2021–2022 financial aid application must be complete before your eligibility for summer Work-Study can be determined. You can check your application status at www.bc.edu/finaidapp.
- You do not need to be enrolled in summer classes; however, you must be registered for fall 2021 classes.
