## Important OSP Process Updates

### Revised Subrecipient Payment Process and Workflow

As discussed in April's OSP Exchange, we are incorporating OSP approval into the Subrecipient invoice payment workflow through PeopleSoft.

Uniform Guidance requires Boston College to conform with its subrecipient regulations (Refer to 2 CFR 200.330 for details). Boston College could be subject to a federal audit and any non-compliance could result in substantial fines and penalties and expose the University to increased federal scrutiny and regulatory compliance.

As a result of our internal subrecipient audit, new internal controls have been put in place regarding the processing of sponsored funded subrecipient invoice payments, effective June 1st, 2022, the start of FY23.

Notable changes and enforcements within the subrecipient invoice payment process are as follows:

- 1. OSP will be inserted into the PeopleSoft workflow to review the invoice payment for allocability, allowability, budget, and PI attestations.
- 2. All Subrecipient invoice payment requests must be accompanied by a completed OSP Subrecipient Invoice Checklist to ensure proper internal controls and reviews have taken place at the departmental level.

- 3. All invoices must be reviewed and signed off by BC's Principal Investigator, certifying their approval and attesting to the charges from the subrecipient.

- 5. Below are the steps to be followed within the subrecipient invoice approval process:
  - a. Department Research Administrator sets up the PO in PeopleSoft for the awarded amount for the budget period.
  - b. Department Research Administrator uploads a copy of the signed subaward agreement with the PO Requisition Request in PeopleSoft.
- **c.** Department Research Administrator monitors for timely receipt of subrecipient invoices.
- d. Department Research Administrator reviews invoices against OSP Subrecipient Invoice Checklist.
- e. Department Research Administrator forwards subrecipient invoice, supporting documentation and completed OSP Subrecipient Invoice Checklist to Principal Investigator.
- f. Principal Investigator approves invoices as evidenced by signature including PI attestation certification statement.
- g. Department Research Administrator uploads the signed subrecipient invoice, subrecipient invoice checklist, and any supporting documentation into PeopleSoft for payment processing.
  - h. OSP reviews and approves subrecipient invoice for payment in PeopleSofti. Procurement creates payment and sends to subrecipient.
- j. Department Research Administrator verifies proper posting of invoices by timely reviewing TDR/ACR reports.

NSF has issued an updated version of the table entitled *NSF Pre-award and Post-award Disclosures Relating to the Biographical Sketch and Current and Pending Support.* The table dated April 20, 2022 updates information on postdoctoral scholars, students, or visiting scholars and differentiates between research activities that are intended for use on the project/proposal being proposed and those that are not. A definition of honorarium also has been added to the table. In addition, the Frequently Asked Questions Regarding Current and Pending Support have been updated and new questions have been added.
